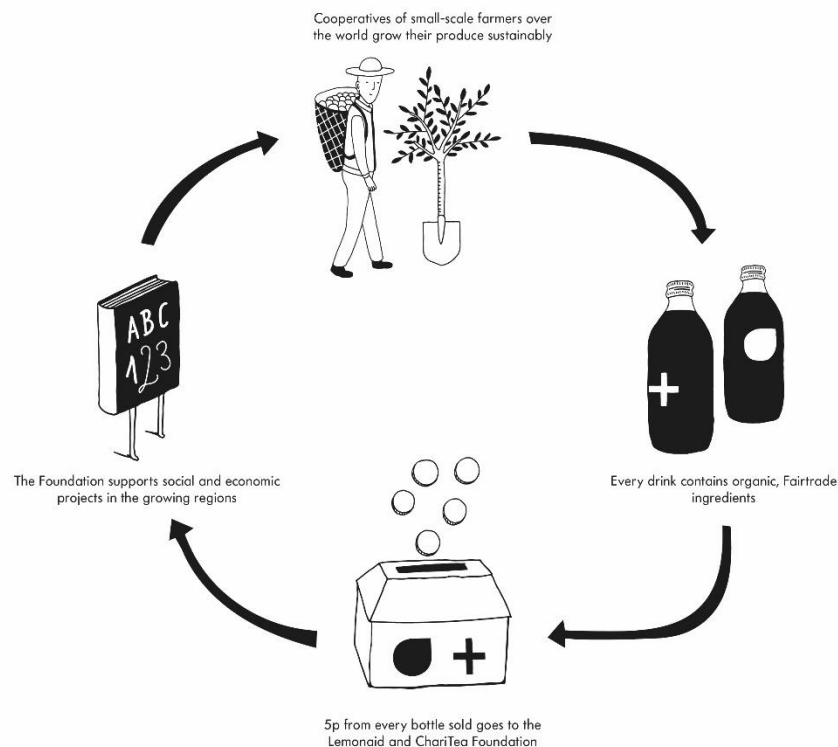


PATRONSHIP FOR RESTAURATEURS & RETAILERS.

About the organisation.

The Lemonaid & Charitea Foundation is a charitable organization which was founded in 2010 in Hamburg - St. Pauli. Its work focusses on improving the social, economic as well as ecological structures in the Global South. Primarily in regions that have been negatively affected by the unequal access to agricultural value creation in the current global system.

The challenges addressed are versatile and we believe that they can only be solved through the self-determined participation of the local population. That is why the Lemonaid & ChariTea Foundation places responsibility and ownership for the implementation of projects, which aim at strengthening regional potentials, with local partners. In practice this means that projects are supported which aim at generating sustainable sources, contribute to agricultural development, permit access to finance and focus on entrepreneurial and further training. These projects eventually will allow the people and communities to improve their living conditions actively and autonomously and consequently live a dignified and self-determined life.

As of 2018, over 3 million euros have so far been raised for the projects we support.

To be absolutely certain that this money is being used as effectively as possible, we don't rely on third parties. We choose our projects directly, and pay regular project visits ourselves to see how things are progressing. This means we get to know the local people and project partners during each successive visit, and discover where support is most urgently needed.
